

## 2014-2015 LMTA Carol Klose Memorial Composition Competition

### Requirements:

The composition may be for any instrument, voice or group. The music and words must be original. A composition that makes use of copyrighted text must be accompanied by a written statement from the copyright holder giving permission to use the text. If the text is in the public domain, a statement signed by the student and teacher indicating this fact must accompany the entry.

Participants who have previously entered a piece in an LMTA contest must enter a new original piece. A student may submit only one (1) entry.

Students, please submit 2 copies of your composition (on 8 1/2 x 11 paper) preferably in ink (or in erasable pen or dark #1 lead pencil) in students own handwriting or notated by the student, on the computer. One copy must be labeled with the title of the composition, the name of the student, the group (Early Elementary, Late Elementary, etc.) and the name of the teacher. The second copy must not include the name of the student or teacher, but should include the title of the composition and category. The music must have at least 1/2-inch margins on all 4 edges. In addition, a recording of the composition must accompany the 2 written copies.

There will be six groups with prizes given in each for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners.

The groups are: Early Elementary (ages 5-7as of 1-1-2016) Late Elem (ages 8-10as of 1-1-2016), Junior (ages 11-14 as of 1-1-2016), Senior (ages 15-18 as of 1-1-2016), Adult Student Teacher

Entrants must have prepared the composition with the LMTA teacher listed on the registration blank. There will be a **performance of the winning compositions at 5:00pm on Sunday, April 19, 2015**, at Grace Lutheran Church, 22<sup>nd</sup> & Washington Streets. Students are to be prepared to play their piece or have someone else perform it.

The fee for the contest is \$8.00 for Early Elementary and \$10.00 for all other groups.

The fee, registration blank, a recording and two copies of your composition must be submitted to your teacher. The teacher will submit the fee, registration blanks, recordings and compositions to Marina Fabrikant. **Postmark deadline is Friday, February 13, 2015.**
